Official Door Prize Rules

- 1. Door Prize.** Five (5) \$1,000 credits toward the *Irrigation Leader* Magazine tour of Chile on February 24-28, 2019.
- 2. Eligibility.** Door-prize eligibility is open to (1) all irrigation, natural resources, or municipal water district or agency representatives who attend the 2019 *Irrigation Leader* O&M Workshop; (2) anyone who has placed a deposit on the 2019 *Irrigation Leader* tour of Chile. Door-prize eligible entrants must be 21 years of age or older.
- 3. How to Enter.** Eligible entrants who would like the opportunity to receive a 2019 *Irrigation Leader* O&M Workshop Door Prize will receive a ticket at the start of the workshop. Ticket holders should write their full name on the back of the ticket, deposit it in the appropriate ticket container at the registration table and retain their ticket stub for the duration of the workshop. *Only one ticket per eligible entrant.*

No payment, proof of purchase, or entry fee is required. Irrigation, natural resources, or municipal water district or agency representatives not attending the 2019 *Irrigation Leader* Workshop may enter the drawing as a guest entrant and can attend the event during the drawing only. Water Strategies is not responsible if a potential guest entrant does not send for qualifying information in time to enter the drawing.
